A FIXED, UNAFRAID HEART

Ps 112:1 Praise ye the LORD. Blessed is the man that feareth the LORD, that delighteth greatly in his commandments.

Ps 112:6-8 Surely he shall not be moved for ever: the righteous shall be in everlasting remembrance. He shall not be afraid of evil tidings: his heart is fixed, trusting in the LORD. His heart is established, he shall not be afraid.

We are living in a world full of fear. The media has our world worked up into panic mode. Nobody I know and nobody you know has the Corona Virus, yet the world is acting like it is everywhere and every person you meet has it. That is a lie! The media wants us to be afraid, but the Word of God tells us hundreds of times, not to be afraid.

Who are you going to listen to? Who are you going to believe? God or man? The Bible or the media? I'm going to listen to what God has to say and live like He tells me to live.

Psa. 112 tells us about a man who does not live in fear. His life is not filled with apprehension. He is not intimidated by the uncertainty of life. He does not sit around listening to the news and getting all worked up into a frenzy of hysteria.

Ps 37:39-40 But the salvation of the righteous is of the LORD: he is their strength in the time of trouble. And the LORD shall help them and deliver them: he shall deliver them from the wicked, and save them, because they trust in him.
