THE GOD WHO IS HOLY

Moses was a man who experienced the supernatural power of God. On the back side of the desert, He had an encounter with God that would change his life forever.

Ex 3:1-5 Now Moses kept the flock of Jethro his father in law, the priest of Midian: and he led the flock to the backside of the desert, and came to the mountain of God, even to Horeb. And the angel of the LORD appeared unto him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush: and he looked, and, behold, the bush burned with fire, and the bush was not consumed. And Moses said, I will now turn aside, and see this great sight, why the bush is not burnt. And when the LORD saw that he turned aside to see, God called unto him out of the midst of the bush, and said, Moses, Moses. And he said, Here am I. And he said, Draw not nigh hither: put off thy shoes from off thy feet, for the place where on thou standest is holy ground.

Why was the ground holy? Because that's where God happened to be at that particular time. Any place where God is, is holy, because He is a holy God!

Man is sinful. Ever since sin entered into the Garden of Eden, man has been separated from God because of sin and disobedience.

Man is not worthy to be in the presence of God.

There isn't even a good illustration that I could give you to demonstrate the disparity that exists between our unrighteousness and His righteousness.

God is in a category of His own. Perfect. Pure. Righteous. In Him, there is no sin, no darkness, and no evil. Not even a hint of impurity can be found in His character.

The Bible lets us know that preparation has to take place in order for man to be in the presence of God. We are told to prepare ourselves. To consecrate ourselves.

God doesn't want us to take His Spirit lightly or presume upon His presence.

God told Moses to take off his shoes. Why? Because he wanted Moses to understand that He is a Holy God and He wants us to honor and respect Him for who He is.

If we will prepare ourselves, God will meet us in a supernatural way and our lives will never be the same again.
